

Flower Chain, Double – Basic Directions

Aspect ratio: 5.5 or larger

Class exercise ring size:

- 18 AWG (1.02mm) 0.250" (6.4mm)

1. Close 2 red rings.



2. Close 2 green rings through the red rings. Note the direction the pair of rings spiral into the center and go under the other pair of rings. The rings in the picture spiral under the other rings in a clockwise direction. The direction of the spiral may be changed at this step by flipping one of the pairs of rings.



3. Close 2 plain rings through both the red and the green rings. Align the plain rings so they spiral into the center and under the other rings in the same direction as the other rings. Carefully set down this “flower”.



4. Repeat steps 1, 2, and 3 to make another “flower”. Note that in the picture on the right the two “flowers” spiral in different directions. The direction of the spiral may be changed in step 2 by flipping the second pair of rings before the third pair of rings is added.



5. Note in the picture on the right that both “flowers” spiral in the same direction.



6. You may either make all the “flowers” you need for your project, or make them as you build the chain.

7. Carefully pick up a “flower” and insert a tail wire through the center.



8. Insert a blue ring through the previous “flower”, carefully pick up another “flower” and add it to the blue ring, and close the blue ring. Insert a second blue ring parallel to the first and close it.



9. Repeat step 8 until complete.
