

Vipera Berus Kinged – Basic Directions

Similar weaves: Orbital Vipera Berus, Viper Basket, Vipera Berus

Aspect ratio 5.5

Class exercise ring size:

- 18 AWG (1.02mm) - ID 0.234" (6.0mm)

1. “Eye” notation: Adding a ring “through the eye” means that the new ring will go through the two rings at point “A”. “Around the eye” means that the new ring will go through both of the rings at points “B” and “B”. “Outside the eye” means that the new ring will go through one of the rings at point “B”, which ring will be covered in the directions.



2. Build a 2-in-2 chain using the red and blue jump rings. Alternate colors in the chain.



3. Twist the chain slightly so that the second pair of red rings in the backbone chain lies on top of the first pair of red rings. Insert a pair of plain jump rings up through the pair of red rings on the right, around the eye, and down through the pair of red rings on the left as shown.



4. Turn the chain over and twist it slightly so that the second pair of blue rings in the backbone chain lies on top of the first pair of blue rings. Insert a pair of plain rings up through the pair of blue rings on the right, around the eye, and down through the pair of blue rings on the left as shown.



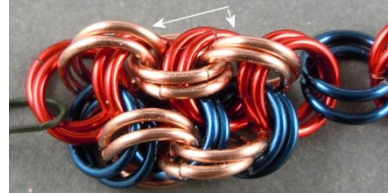
5. Turn the chain over and twist it slightly so that the third pair of red rings in the backbone chain lies on top of the second pair of red rings. Insert a pair of plain rings up through the pair of red rings on the right, around the eye, and down through the pair of plain rings and the pair of red rings on the left as shown.



6. Turn the chain over and twist it slightly so that the third pair of blue ring in the backbone chain lies on top of the second pair of blue rings. Insert a pair of plain rings up through the pair of blue rings on the right, around the eye, and down through the pair of plain rings and the pair of blue rings on the left as shown.



7. Turn the chain over and twist it slightly so that the next pair of red ring in the backbone chain lies on top of the previous pair of red rings. Insert a pair of plain rings up through the pair of red rings on the right and down through the pair of plain rings, around the eye, and the pair of red rings on the left as shown. Note that the two pairs of plain rings go through the middle pair of plain rings in the same direction.



8. Turn the chain over and twist it slightly so that the next pair of blue rings in the backbone chain lies on top of the previous pair of blue rings. Insert a pair of plain rings up through the pair of blue rings on the right, around the eye, and down through the pair of plain rings and the pair of blue rings on the left as shown. Note that the two pairs of plain rings go through the middle pair of plain rings in the same direction.



9. Turn the chain over and twist it slightly so that the next pair of ring in the backbone chain lies on top of the previous pair of ring of the same color. Insert a pair of plain rings up through the pair of rings on the right, around the eye, and down through the pair of plain rings and the pair of rings on the left as shown. Note that the two pairs of plain rings go through the middle pair of plain rings in the same direction.



10. Repeat the previous step until done.
